Article 49-3 of the French Constitution gives the possibility to the Prime Minister, after deliberation by the Council of Ministers, to liability of the Government on the vote of a bill. If the head of government decides to use it, the decision results in immediate suspension of the discussion of the document. Having participated in 2012 in the development of the economic program of Francois Hollande, Ms Berger said today disappointed by the executive and believes M.Valls has no legitimacy. The French government is preparing to again resort to Article 49-3, which allows the adoption without a vote of a law for the second reading of the labor bill to the National Assembly. "Personally, I consider that the use of 49-3 twice testifies to the fact that he no longer the majority in the Assembly with him and that, therefore, motion of censure or no confidence motion, it was 49-3 early in the second reading, the Prime Minister could not stay. he should resign, "said the member who declares himself" stunned "by the speech of M.Valls.
